2. A brief statement [200 words or less] describing:


- Who are you? [for example: personal history, interests, hobbies, challenges faced]
- What have you done? [for example: courses; grades; awards; extracurricular or civic activities; challenges overcome]
- What do you hope to have accomplished 10 years from now? [for example: college or trade school education; career aspirations; consequential life goals]

3. A brief essay [200 words or less] on: "This is What Democracy Looks Like"

Applications are due by March 31. The committee will notify you (the school guidance counselor) of our selection by April 15. We will have someone at the awards ceremony in May to present the award and a check to the successful applicant.
